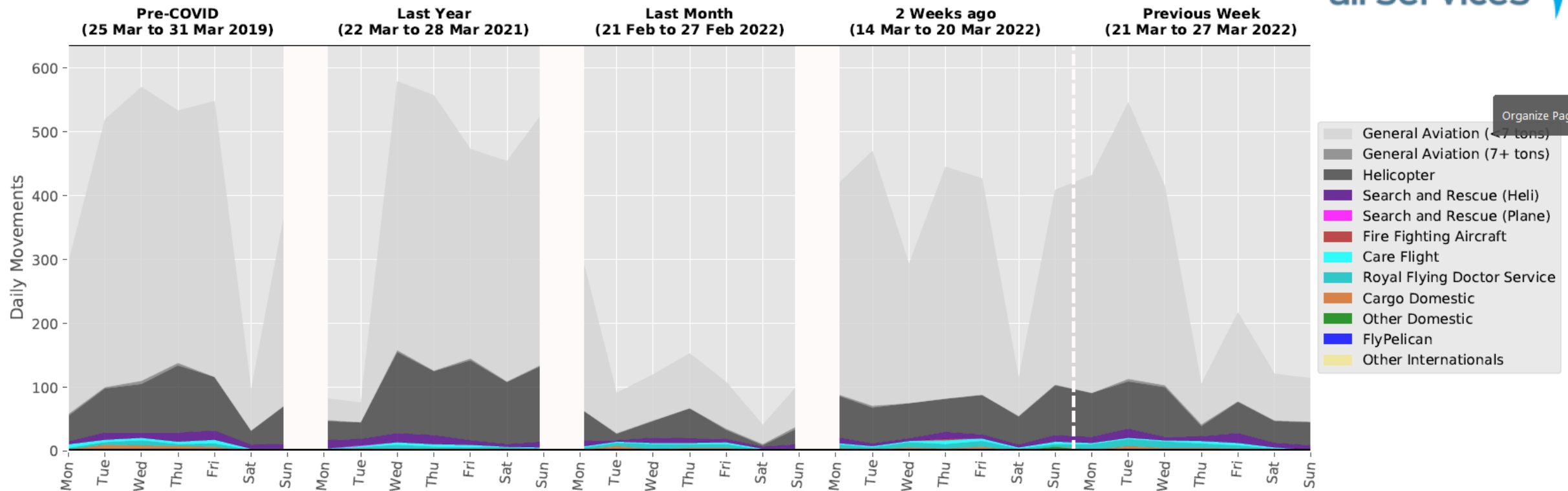

## Daily Aircraft Movements: BANKSTOWN AIRPORT (YSBK) ATC Tower Location

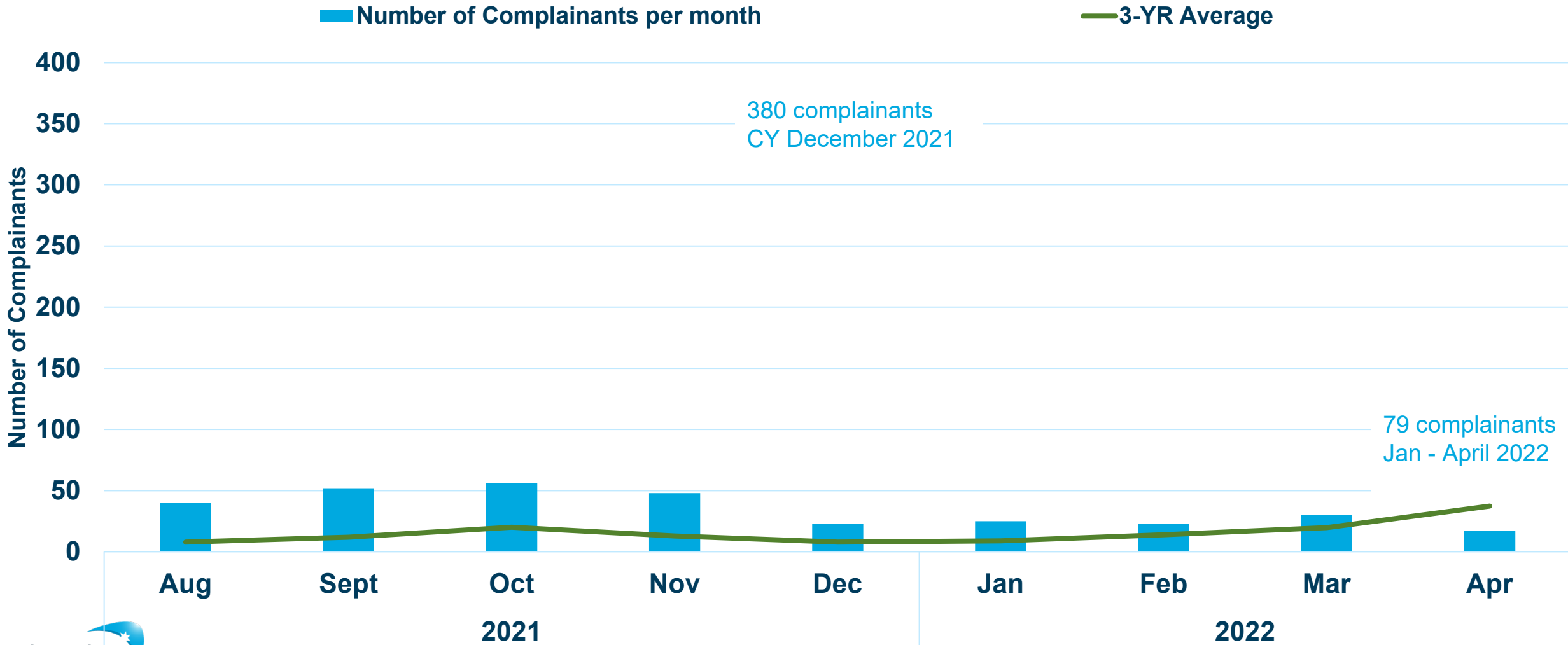


- Other Internationals are Foreign Airlines as well as Short Haul Internationals of Regional Airlines.

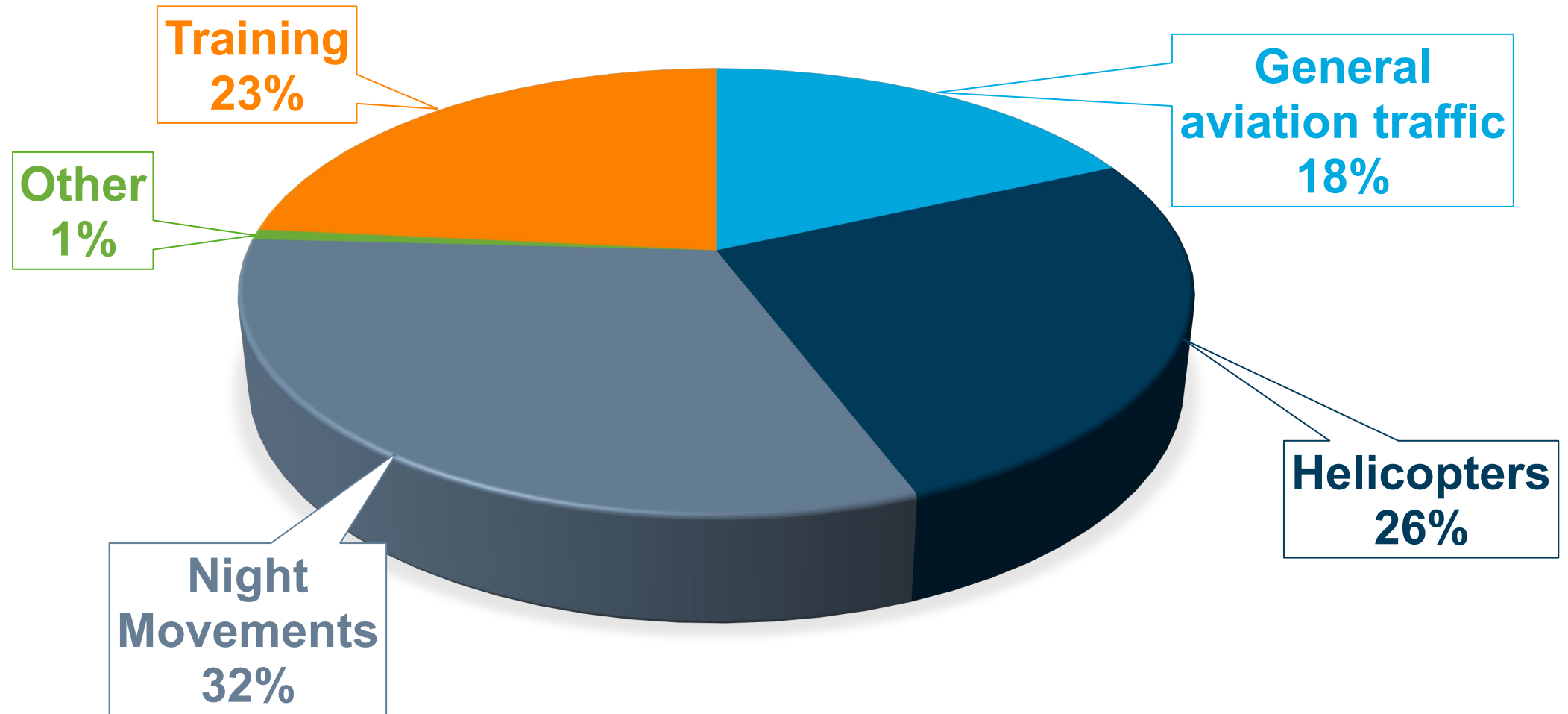
Data shown via Stacked Area plots. The values of each group are displayed on top of each other. Movements exclude military but include VFR without FPL. All dates based on local times.

# NCIS UPDATE

## AUGUST 2021 TO APRIL 2022

### COMPLAINANTS

- 261 individual complainants
- 510 complaints

### ISSUES

#### Main issues raised:

- **Night movements** (7)
  - emergency services ops – 78
  - standard ops/VFR - 4
  - unknown 3
- **Helicopters**
  - emergency services ops – 40,
  - airwork – 19,
  - standard operations – 9
  - unknown - 2
- **Training**
  - fixed-wing circuit training– 62
  - helicopter circuit training – 1,

### SUBURBS

- 142 suburbs recorded complainants
- Milperra recorded the most complainants – 25
- Panania – 20
- Chipping Norton & Revesby – 10 each
- 101 suburbs recorded a single complainant
- 7 suburbs recorded 5 or more complainants

# NCIS UPDATE

## 2021 YEAR IN REVIEW

### COMPLAINANTS

- 380 individual complainants,
- 620 complaints
- An increase from 159 individual complainants in 2020, 110 in 2019
- COVID-19 main reason for increase
  - Working from home and increased exposure to aircraft noise
  - Increased emergency services operations from Bankstown Airport to facilitate the response to the pandemic

### ISSUES

- **Training:** main issue affecting 63 of residents. 97% of these residents concerned with fixed wing circuit training
- **General Aviation traffic:** affected 59 residents, with 46% concerned with standard flight routes to and from the airport, and 51% concerned with emergency services operations
- **Helicopters:** concerned 148 residents, with 28% affected by emergency services operations, airwork affected 67% and standard operations 4%
- **Night Movements:** affected 117 residents, 94% by emergency services operations
- **Emergency Services:** these affected 48% of all complainants in 2021, and affected 120 suburbs

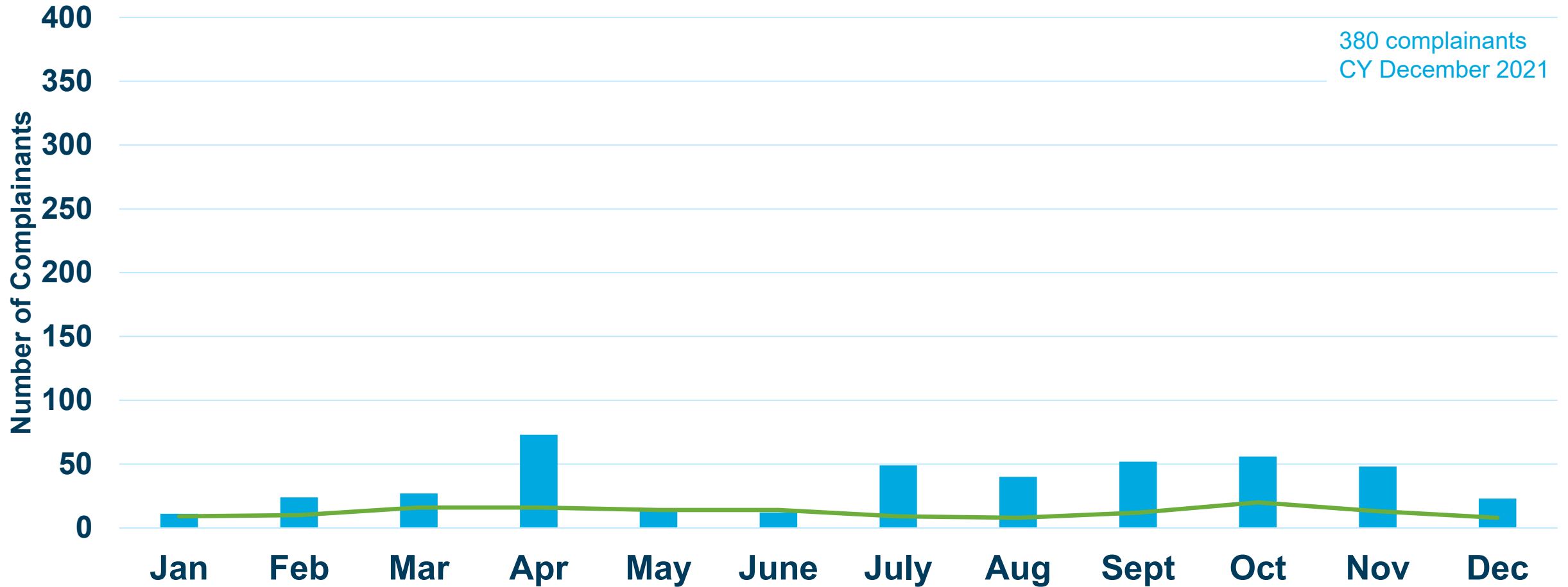
### SUBURBS

- 178 separate suburbs across the greater Sydney basin recorded complainants
- Five recorded 10 or more complainants
- 116 suburbs recorded a single complainant
- Suburbs with most complainants
  - Milperra (26)
  - Panania (20)
  - Revesby (14)
  - Lane Cove (14)
  - Lane Cove North (12)

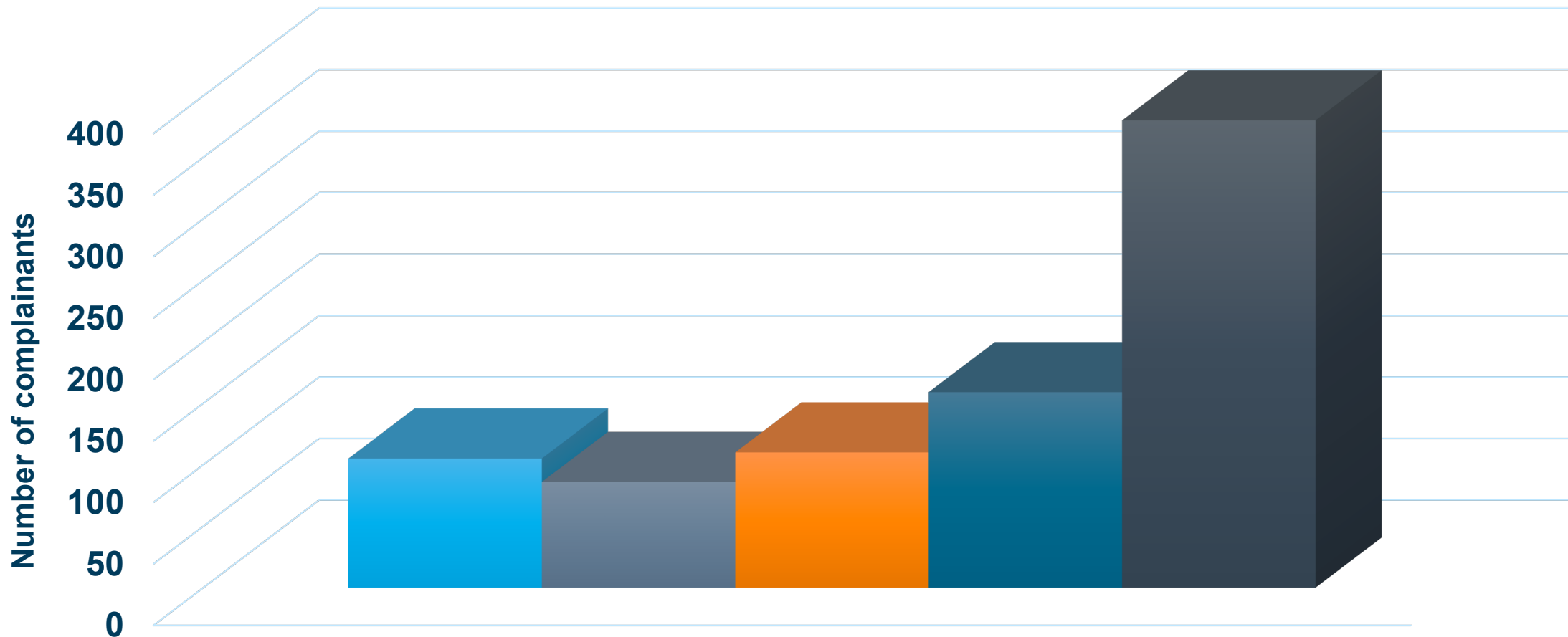
# NCIS UPDATE – 2021 YEAR IN REVIEW - COMPLAINANTS

■ Number of Complainants per month      — 3-YR Average

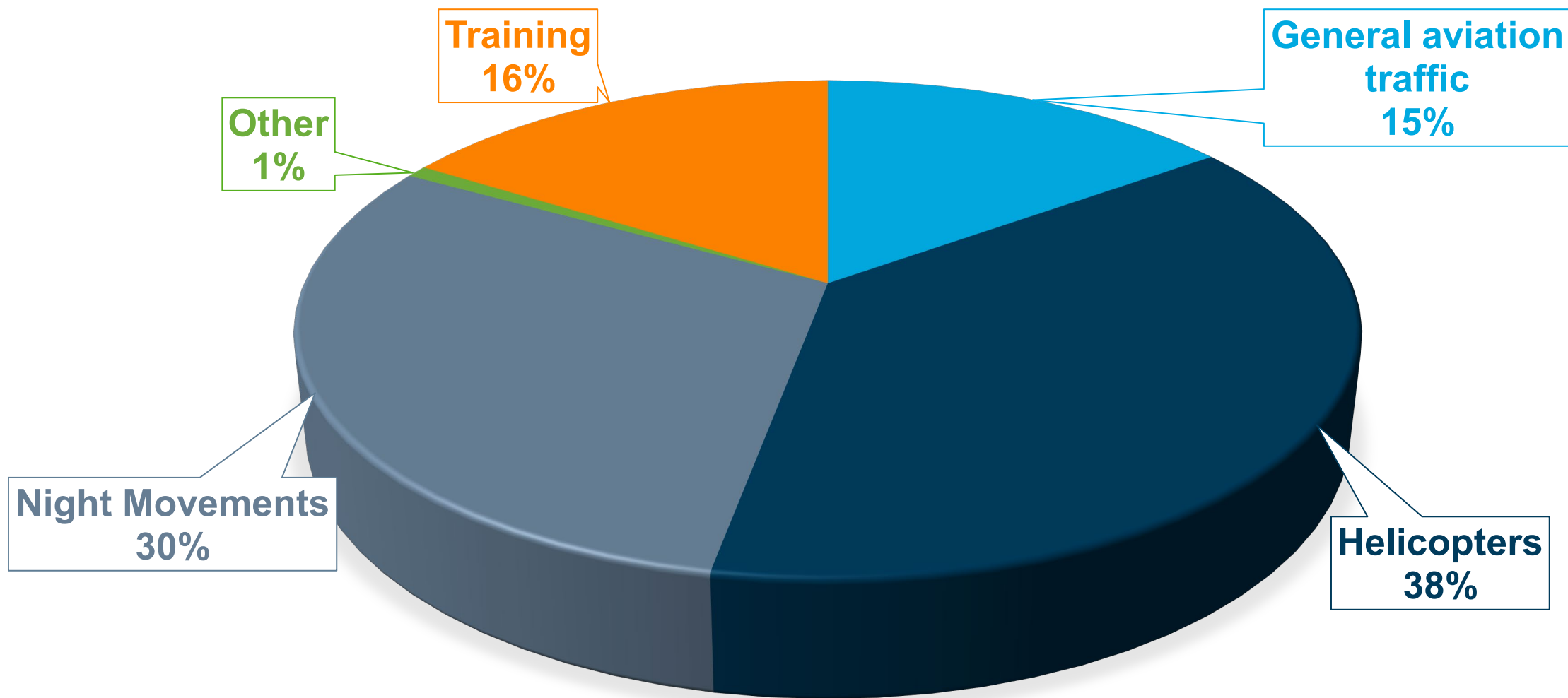

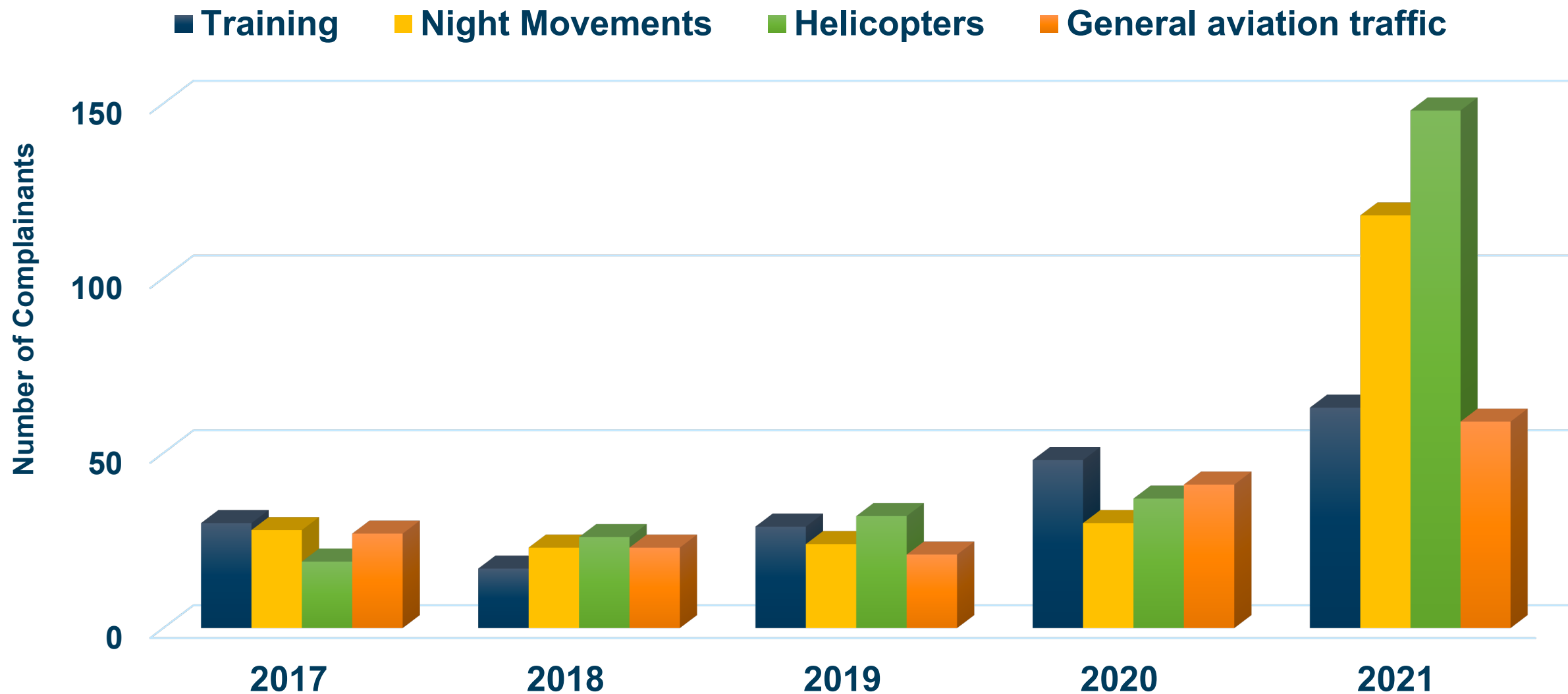

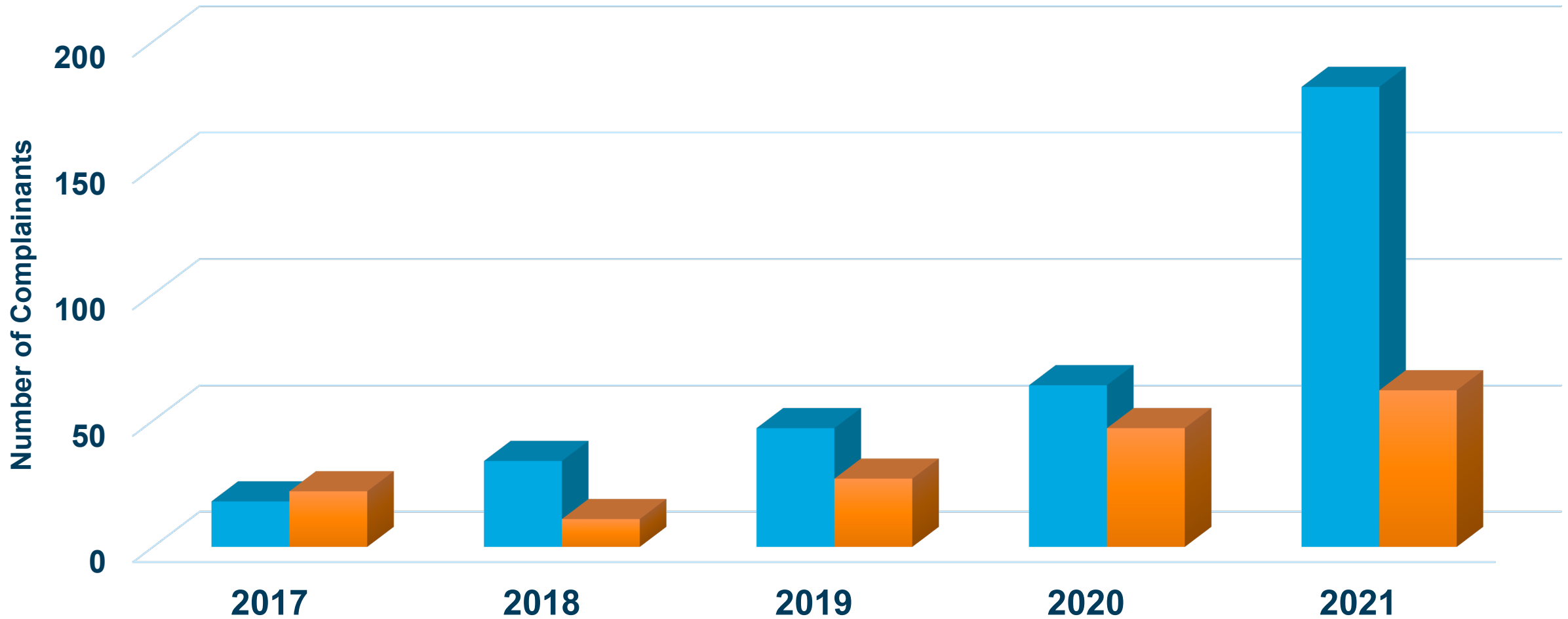

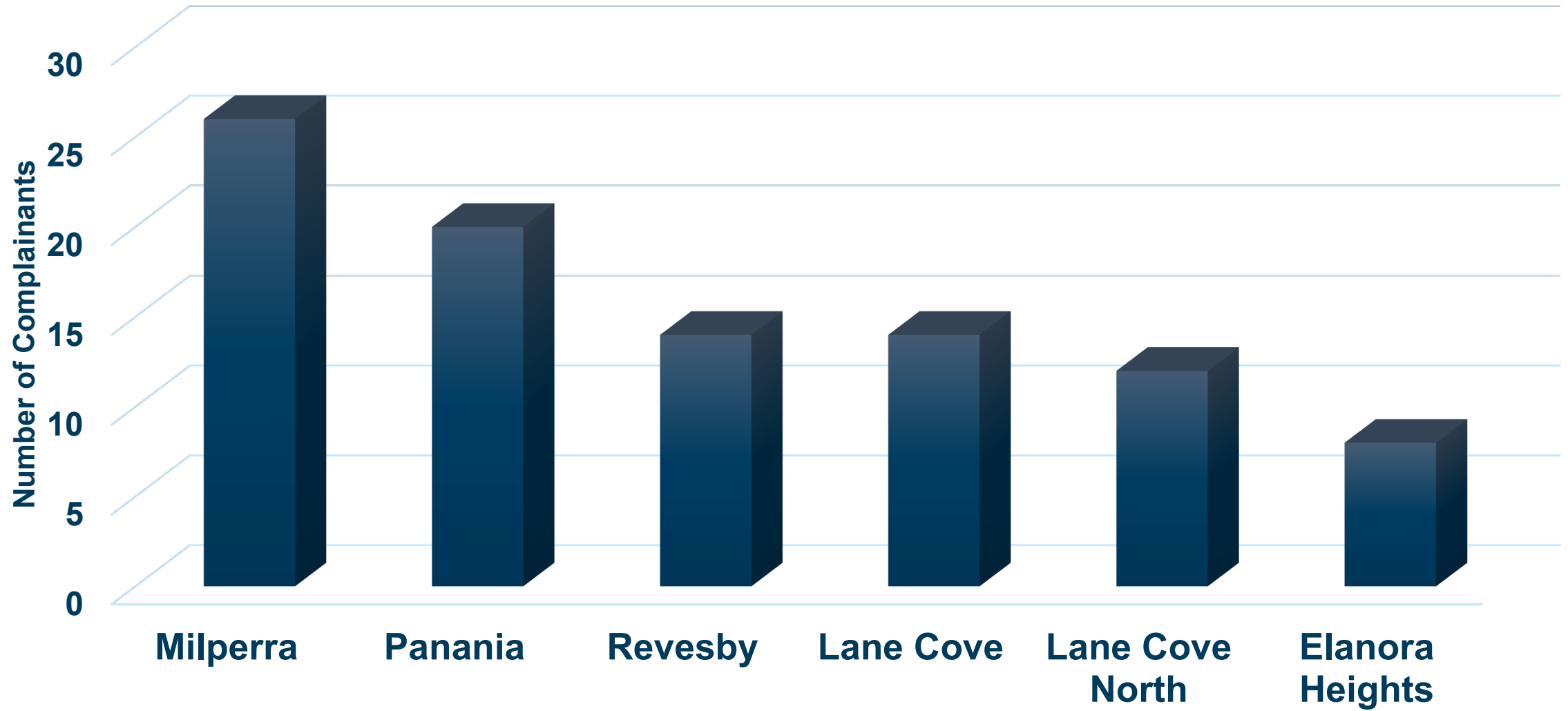
