

## Maintenance Claim Form (Bankstown Airport)

**It is the responsibility of the aircraft owner or operator to submit this Maintenance Claim Form with all supporting documentation.**

An aircraft is entitled to the Maintenance Discount listed in the Conditions of Use for a maximum of 3 months if it meets all the following conditions:

- the aircraft MTOW is less than 5,000kg;
- the aircraft is undergoing substantial maintenance at Bankstown Airport;
- the aircraft operator or owner does not have any accounts in arrears with Bankstown Airport Pty Limited; and
- the following documents are submitted to [aviation@aeria.co](mailto:aviation@aeria.co) within 3 days of the maintenance release:
  - Completed and signed version of this Maintenance Claim Form
  - Documentation evidence of the date maintenance commenced (for example technical log entry or maintenance log entry)
  - Documentation evidence of the maintenance release (for example Maintenance Release or Certificate of Release to Service)
- Bankstown Airport Pty Limited approves the Maintenance Claim Form

If any of these conditions are not met, normal charges as per the Conditions of Use will apply.
