

### Airside Driving Logbook

Cat 2- Allows you to drive on Airside Perimeter Road and Aprons. To obtain this licence it is a requirement that you must spend **2 hours** as an observer and **2 hours** as a supervised driver in a vehicle airside

Cat 3- Allows you to drive on Cat 2 and manoeuvring areas (excluding runway complex) Taxiways 'E' (between TWY 'F' and TWY 'J') and Taxiway 'B' are only available for aircraft undertow. To obtain this licence you must hold a Aeronautical Radio Operator Certificate (AROC), spend **4 hours** as an observer and **4 hours** as a supervised driver in a vehicle airside and also complete a practical driving test.
