Airside Driving Logbook

Cat 2- Allows you to drive on Airside Perimeter Road and Aprons. To obtain this licence it is a requirement that you must spend <u>2 hours</u> as an observer and <u>2 hours</u> as a supervised driver in a vehicle airside

Cat 3- Allows you to drive on Cat 2 and manoeuvring areas (excluding runway complex) Taxiways 'E'(between TWY 'F' and TWY 'J') and Taxiway 'B' are only available for aircraft undertow. To obtain this licence you must hold a Aeronautical Radio Operator Certificate (AROC), spend 4 hours as an observer and 4 hours as a supervised driver in a vehicle airside and also complete a practical driving test.
